### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

### AWARDS OF MERIT

At a specialty show, often the number of quality dogs far exceeds the number of top awards available. An award of merit acknowledges that the animal was under consideration for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex. Three (3) awards of merit (each event) may be presented in addition to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. The judge may, at his/her discretion, award all or none of the rosettes.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

VETERAN DOG, 7 years & older    VETERAN BITCH, 7 years & older

Veteran Dogs and Bitches will be judged the first classes of the day.

Note: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches allowed to compete in Veterans and all other single entry non-regular classes only at independent specialties 1<sup>st</sup> place in these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**\*STUD DOG CLASS** - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The Stud Dog must be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition.

**\*BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as the Stud Dog Class, substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get."

*\*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

**BRACE CLASS** - For two dogs, irrespective of sex, with identical ownership. This is an additional class only for dogs that are entered in a regular class at this show. \$20.00 per brace unit.

**TEAM CLASS** - For four dogs, irrespective of sex, with identical ownership. This is an additional class only for dogs that are entered in a regular class at this show. \$20.00 per Team.

### BEST PUPPY

Best Puppy competition will be for winners of the puppy dog and puppy bitch 6-9 and 9-12 classes only. Dogs over 12 months of age are not considered puppies. Judging will take place after Best of Breed Competition.

### BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR

Best Bred-By Exhibitor competition will be for winners of the Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy & Adult (dog & bitch) classes only. Judging will take place after Best of Breed Competition.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP Irish Wolfhounds Only

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

### **NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:**

- **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

**NOTE:** SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

**BEST JUNIOR HANDLER** - The Junior Handlers placing first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for Best Junior Handler.

**NOTE** - Junior Handler, awarded Best Junior Handler at this Specialty, will be eligible to compete in the Greeley Kennel Club, Best Overall Junior Showmanship Competition, Monday, August 21, 2023. Refer to the Greeley Kennel Club, Inc., Premium List for details.

Prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Event Secretary advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. Awards can be mailed.

## SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

**Eligibility:** This Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Wolfhounds, who, on the day of the show, will be at least six months and under eighteen months of age. Champions of record are ineligible. Classes to be divided by sex and age. **Dogs shown in Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes.** Professional handlers and their assistants who regularly make themselves available for handling in exchange for monetary compensation may only show dogs bred or owned by them. Indicate "Sweepstake & Age Division" in the Additional Classes space.

**Junior and Senior Stakes will be judged separately and there will be no competition between the two divisions.**

### JUNIOR SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Puppy Dog, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.      Puppy Bitch, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.

Puppy Dog, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.      Puppy Bitch, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.

The class winners will compete for Best in Junior Sweepstakes & Best Opposite in Junior Sweepstakes.

### SENIOR SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Dog, 12 mos. & under 15 mos      Bitch, 12 mos. & under 15 mos

Dog, 15 mos. & under 18 mos.      Bitch, 15 mos. & under 18 mos

The class winners will compete for Best in Senior Sweepstakes & Best Opposite in Senior Sweepstakes.

### DIVISION OF STAKES

All entry money in each class will be divided as follows. All prize money is paid in the ring to the person handling the dog. *Any undistributed funds revert to the Club.*

- 25% of total Sweepstakes fees will be retained by the club for expenses.
- 75% of the total Sweepstakes fees is divided as follows:  
First Place – 30%, Second Place – 20%, Third Place – 15%, Fourth Place – 10%.

A gold-toned or silver-toned IAWC Specialty Medallion will be awarded to the winners of Best and Best Opposite in Junior and Senior Sweeps.

### ♥♥♥ HEART STUDY ♥♥♥

Cardiac screening sponsored by the Irish Wolfhound Foundation will be on April 10 for hounds two years and older. Testing will be provided by board-certified veterinary cardiologist Dr. Brett Boorstin. Screening will include auscultation, EKG and echocardiogram. Testing for OFA will be available but must be requested when you register for the clinic. Registration for the Heart Clinic will close two weeks before the show, on March 27, 2026.

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are **not acceptable**. - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
